MENTORING- AND ASSESSMENTDAYS IN TUZLA/BOSNIA

14TH TO 17TH OF DECEMBER 2017

It's time for celebration!



On 17th of December we celebrated the certification of the first Bosnian trainers for Nonviolent Communication:

Ivona Erdeljac Ivana Pejic Ingrid Halbritter

Ivona is on her way for about 20 years! and learnt from Marshall, Verena. Laurence and some more. She is working in Amica Educa, an organisation for education of women.

Ivana is a teacher and offers workshops for teachers. She is in deep connection with Verena.

Ingrid is a German woman working in Bosnia before all as social worker with Roma, supporting them to get legal acknowledgement. This works by financing journeys to birthplace and paying the costs for identification documents, so that health insurance can be offered, marriages are possible, they can apply for certificates of birth for own children.

In 2016 these three women found each other by support of Verena, met and invited Doris to come to Tuzla. There was a meeting of NVC interested people with the idea to found a Bosnian network for NVC.

Doris offered her experience from DACH network and made an introduction of Systemic consensing and decision making. The BIH (Bosnian and Herzegowina) Network has been founded and DACH (German NVC network) is partner and mentor.

During the last year the BIH NVC Network was very busy:

- Mentoring- and Assessmentdays (MAD) in January with Edith and Doris took place
- A training with Susana Rusch
- Another MAD in December, where 3 candidates were recommended for certification

In the time between the members of the BIH NVC Network met, supported each other and offered a lot of workshops, especially for teachers.

Two organisations in Tuzla support this: Amica Educa and Mios. They provide room and workshop support. Support by finances is given by Eirene (Paul den Hartog) and DACH: collecting donations and practical support.

Muios supported the MAD in December by hosting the group of 8 candidates and some advanced practitioners of NVC. Edina Malkic from Muios organized a training for teachers.

25 teachers took part and together with the members of BIH NVC Network Doris and Edith offered an advanced training. To meet international trainers is in Bosnia still something "special and extraordinary", as this country is not in EU.

Certification of Bosnian trainers means empowerment, support and acknowledgement, which is very important for spreading NVC officially. Now they belong to the international community and are fully included. It was very moving to experience the joy about this! And this energy will strongly contribute to the growth of NVC in Bosnia and neighbour countries!

The next candidates are close to certification and now it is time to find strategies for them to fulfil the requirements for certification like attending an IIT and collecting feedbacks from certified trainers. If you enjoy to contribute please send money with subject Bosnia to:
